LITURGY OF THE WORD

Christ became obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

During his journey to Golgotha, Jesus goes from hailed hero to crucified criminal. He surrenders out of obedience to his Father and love for us. As followers of Jesus, we, too, can face loss and sacrifice. Jesus knows what it means to sacrifice out of love. We journey together through loss, never alone, but always united with Jesus.

In the Gospel for the procession, Jesus enters Jerusalem amid an enthusiastic crowd. In the first reading, Isaiah speaks for the Lord, despite opposition. In the second reading, Paul writes to the Philippians that Jesus emptied himself, becoming obedient to the point of death. Mark's Gospel tells the story of Jesus' passion and death.

Taylor Chikotas, a member of Christ the King Mission Church, is seeking to build a lean-to roof addition at the entrance of the Benton Food Pantry. He has a goal of fundraising \$700.

Below is his letter for reference.

Your support is most appreciated!

Dear Christ the King Community,

As you may have heard I have started to begin work on my Eagle Project for Scouts. The Eagle Scout Award is the highest award in Scouts, earned by completing awards that promote community service, personal growth, positive values, and leadership skills. The last step in earning the Eagle Award is a community project that addresses the root cause of an issue I am passionate about and meets a need in my community (Millville, PA).

For my service hours in both Scouts and for the Future Farmers of America I have volunteered at the Greenwood Township, Madison Township, and Millville Borough Food Pantry every month for the past two years. Through volunteering I became aware of the need for a shelter at the pantry for inclement weather on food distribution days. It is because of this awareness that I wish to do what I can to help the pantry, its patrons, and its volunteers to stay safe during inclement weather.

My project is to build a Lean-to Roof addition at the entrance of the food pantry (16' x 16' x 10') as a shelter from inclement weather (rain, snow, and wind). This will provide a dry area for the director and volunteers to distribute the food products to the patrons into their vehicles. If food becomes damaged or falls to the ground it cannot be used and must be disposed of. This project will not only provide a safe area to distribute food but will also save food from being wasted. At present there are approximately 73 persons/families who use the pantry due to food insecurity.

I have started to raise funds for this project. I will need to raise \$4,560.00 for the building and supplies of the Lean-to Roof addition, I am \$700.00 away from my goal. Therefore, I am asking for a small monetary donation that can be put towards reaching my goal. Any amount will be appreciated and put to good use.
