

CHRISTMAS MASS SCHEDULE 2023

This year, Christmas Eve falls on a Sunday. This means that Catholics must go to two distinct Masses on the weekend: one Mass for the 4th Sunday in Advent, and one Mass for Christmas.

At Christ the King, we want to ensure that your pastoral needs are met with the Mass schedule. We will happily provide as many Masses as needed, but in a manner that does not unnecessarily fragment our community during this celebration (especially with smaller attendance due to many traveling for the holidays).

To determine the best way we could serve you all during the Christmas celebration, we conducted a pew survey this weekend. Here are the results.

We had 46 surveys completed (18 completed at the Saturday Vigil, 28 completed Sunday morning).

For the 4th Sunday of Advent:

- 28 said they are going to the Saturday 4pm Mass on December 23rd
- 18 said they are going to the Sunday 9am Mass on December 24th

For Christmas

- 43 said they are going to the Sunday 4pm Mass on December 24th for Christmas Eve
- 3 said that they would like a Mass on Christmas morning at Christ the King

Based on these results, we will have the following Mass schedule:

For the Fourth Sunday of Advent Saturday December 23rd at 4pm Sunday December 24th at 9am

For the Solemnity of the Nativity (Christmas) Sunday December 24th at 4pm

A reminder that 9am Mass on Sunday December 24th does not count for the Christmas obligation. It counts for the obligation for the 4th Sunday of Advent. This means that you have to go to an additional Mass (at Christ the King Sunday evening, at St. Columba during one of their Mass times, or elsewhere).

We will also share St. Columba's Mass schedule with you (as St. Columba Parish will be sharing our Mass schedule).
